


Return Canopy (TCP)



Customers can now keep private conversations private with the Tuttle & Bailey Return Canopy (TCP). The Return Canopy is an easy-to-install accessory for return grilles that reduces crosstalk noise between private offices and conference rooms by becoming a lined, acoustical "shield". The office environment has changed a lot over years with cubicles and collaborative spaces becoming more prevalent. One thing that has not changed, is the need for spaces to have private conversations, such as tactful human resources discussions or a sensitive contract negotiation. Unfortunately, these spaces, and discussions, may not be as private as you think due to the crosstalk through the ceiling plenum. The TCP can mitigate noise by providing a barrier that reduces sound transmission in key speech octave bands between return grilles in different rooms.

Additionally, the Return Canopy reduces sight lines into ceiling plenum spaces.

INSTALLATION

- The TCP Return Canopy is easily installed above the return grille in the plenum space above a ceiling grid as shown
- · Side panels should be oriented toward adjacent returns

- · Reduces crosstalk between return grilles
- · Acts as a light shield and blocks line of sight
- Available in 12 x 12, 24 x 12, 24 x 24 and 48 x 24
- · Fiberglass liner
